- (1) Admission order of ACPUGMEC
- (2) Allotment Letter of ACPUGMEC
- (3) Tuition fee receipt showing the payment of one term (6 months) fees.
- (4) Copy of NEET-UG-2021 Marksheet
- (5) Copy of Marksheet of S.S.C. (Std. 10th) Exam
- (6) Copy of Marksheet of H.S.C. (Std. 12th) Exam
- (7) Documents showing place of birth, date of birth and Indian Citizenship (School leaving Certificate/Transfer Certificate/Passport/Birth Certificate)
- (8) Domicile Certificate (with signature and stamp of authority) issued by competent authorities (Mamlatdar/Executive Magistrate/Commissioner of Police) of Gujarat State only.
- (9) For SEBC, ST AND ST category : Caste certificate issued by competent authorities of Gujarat state only.
- (10) For SEBC Category: Non creamy layer certificate (Parishista : “4” in Gujarat/English) issued by competent authorities of Gujarat state only. (One attested copy)
- (11) Copy of passport (If citizenship in Dual)
- (12) Self attested photocopy of Aadhar card.
- (13) 10 recent passport size photographs with 5 envelopes of size (11’ X 15’)
